\*\*\*\*Dr. Sidney Ingbar to present Bromberg Lecture on Thyroid, Oct. 23

DALLAS -- Dr. Sidney H. Ingbar, professor of medicine at Harvard University, will be the Mr. and Mrs. I. G. Bromberg Visiting Professor of Medicine at The University of Texas Health Science Center at Dallas Oct. 20-24, 1986.

Ingbar's lecture on Thursday, Oct. 23, will be on "Nonhyperthyroid Varieties of Thyrotoxicosis." The lecture will be from 11 a.m. until noon in room D1.502.

Ingbar received his M.D. degree from Harvard and completed a residency in medicine at Boston City Hospital. He served in the U.S. Army Medical Corps at Walter Reed Army Medical Center and has held positions at Boston City Hospital and the University of California at San Francisco. He is now William B. Castle Professor of Medicine at Harvard.

Ingbar is a member of numerous professional societies. He was 1976 president of the American Thyroid Association and is current president of the Endocrine Society. He is active in endocrinology research at the National Institutes of Health and lists more than 300 publications in the field of endocrinology and thyroid function.

The Bromberg Visiting Professorship was established in memory of Mr. and Mrs.

I. G. Bromberg by their daughters Minna Bromberg and Mrs. Essie Bromberg Joseph. The professorship brings an outstanding physician to the campus for one week each year for lectures and rounds in the Department of Internal Medicine.
