Dr. Andres Goth, Professor and Chairman of the Department, will participate in the First Teaching Institute of the Association of American Medical Colleges at Atlantic City on October 19-24.

Drs. William R. Blackmore and Myron Slomka, Assistant Professors, will take part in the Regional Meeting of the Society for Experimental Biology and Medicine at Houston on November 6-8. Dr. Blackmore will discuss "The Effect of Histamine on Renal Hemodynamics and Its Response to Tripeleennamine" and Dr. Slomka will discuss "The Analgetic Effect of the Optical Isomers of Dromoran and Methadon."

On November 11 Dr. Goth will participate in the Postgraduate Program by telephone of the Texas Medical Association at Austin.
