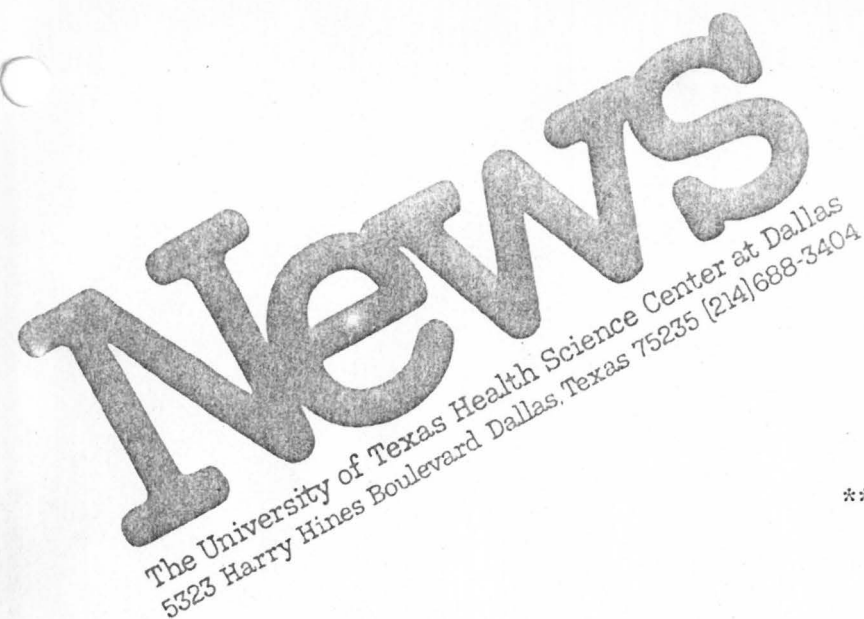

*****Aune accepts appointment

DALLAS--Dr. Janet Aune, former UT System administrator, has recently accepted an appointment at The University of Texas Health Science Center as assistant to Dr. Charles C. Sprague. She began new duties Jan. 1.

The cell biologist, a graduate of Saint Louis University, has been serving as assistant to the vice chancellor for health affairs for The University of Texas System this past year. Prior to that time Aune was executive director of Texas Woman's University's Houston Center where she also served as executive dean in 1975 and was professor of biology. She has served as Texas Coordinator for the National Identification Program for Women in Higher Education since 1977. The educator chaired her last meeting in that capacity here at the health science center in November.

Concentrating on work in aging, Aune did her thesis on "Changes in Leukocyte Physiology During Aging." Her dissertation was on "Ultrastructural Changes During Aging." She is a graduate of the Harvard School of Business Administration's Health Policy and Management Program and the Intergovernmental Administrative Development Training Program of the National Institutes of Health.

Her work at TWU dealt heavily with program development in the areas of cell biology, vital hygiene and medical record keeping. She was named the university's outstanding teacher in 1977.

The author of numerous scientific papers, Aune has served on many review panels for the National Science Foundation. She is listed in American Men and Women of Science, Who's Who of American Women and Who's Who in the South and Southwest. In 1972 she was named Outstanding Educator of America. Her professional memberships include the American Association for Advancement of Science, American Association for Higher Education, Sigma Xi and the Society for Cell Biology.
