******Jean Miller named Director of Library at UTHSCD.

DALLAS--Jean K. Miller, director of The Medical Library Center of New York, has been named director of the library at The University of Texas Health Science Center at Dallas, Vice President Jack Wheeler announced today.

Before going to The Medical Library Center in 1974, Ms. Miller served as associate health sciences librarian for circulation and dissemination at the Health Sciences Library at State University of New York at Buffalo.

Ms. Miller has published professional papers on circulation and information dissemination and served as project director for information dissemination service of the Lakes Area Regional Medical Program.

"Ms. Miller is highly qualified and comes to us highly recommended. She is among the leading librarians in the country and has a lot of experience in the medical field," said Dr. Mary Esther Gaulden, associate professor of radiology and chairman of the Library Committee.

The new director completed courses in computer librarianship and in electronic data processing at Washington University. She holds a master's in library science from Syracuse University as well as a master's in administration of nursing education and a bachelor's in nursing.

She has held various state and national offices in the Medical Library Association, and her current professional commitments include membership on the Biomedical Library Review Committee for the National Library of medicine and chairmanship of the Advisory and Planning Committee for the New York and New Jersey Regional Medical Library.

Ms. Miller will assume her new post in Dallas in October.

Housed in the Florence Bioinformation Center on the health science center campus, the library has space to accommodate more than 400,000 volumes. Current collection totals about 140,000 volumes with about 3,000 serials received. Between 8,000 and 9,000 new books and bound journals are added each year.
