******Internationally-known kidney specialist visits Southwestern as annual Bromberg Visiting Professor of Medicine.*

DALLAS--Dr. Neal S. Bricker, an internationally-known specialist in the area of kidney disease, will visit Southwestern Oct. 21-25 as the Mr. and Mrs. I.G. Bromberg Visiting Professor of Medicine.

He is currently professor and chairman of the Department of Internal Medicine at the Albert Einstein College of Medicine in New York City and is a diplomate of the American Board of Internal Medicine. He is also a visiting investigator at the Institute of Biological Chemistry in Copenhagen and has served in numerous capacities with the National Kidney Foundation.

Dr. Bricker has received many awards, including the National Institutes of Health Research Career Award. He has served on National Academy of Sciences committees dealing with space biology and medicine and renal and metabolic effects of spaceflight.

Hosted by the Department of Internal Medicine, Dr. Bricker will conduct ward rounds and seminars with students and house staff, discuss academic issues with faculty and present lectures.

He is the author of many publications and is currently on the editorial boards of Physiological Reviews and Kidney International. He is a member of Alpha Omega Alpha and the American Association for the Advancement of Science, along with other organizations.
