******Dr. Kemp Clark becomes president of neurosurgical association.

DALLAS--Dr. Kemp Clark, professor and chairman of the Division of Neurosurgery at The University of Texas Southwestern Medical School, was recently installed as president of the prestigious American Association of Neurological Surgeons.

The AANS was founded 50 years ago as the Harvey Cushing Society and has come to represent most of this country's board certified neurosurgeons, now with a membership of 300. In 1965, recognizing the need for a unified voice for American neurosurgeons, it became spokesman organization for the medical specialty. It publishes the "Journal of Neurosurgery" and it provides government agencies and other legislative bodies with information and help in neurosurgical matters.

Clark received his M.D. degree from The University of Texas Medical Branch at Galveston in 1948 and was trained in neurosurgery at the Neurological Institute of New York. He has been associated with Southwestern since 1956.
