BRITISH UROLOGIST DUE AT SOUTHWESTERN

DALLAS -- Dr. David M. Wallace, of London, England, world authority on treatment of bladder and kidney cancer, will be the annual visiting professor in urology at The University of Texas Southwestern Medical School at Dallas April 28-May 3.

Dr. Wallace has done pioneer work in the use of drug therapy in metastatic kidney cancer. He is attending urologist at Royal Marden Hospital, London.

Dr. Wallace will confer during his stay in Dallas with students and faculty at Southwestern on problems encountered in treatment of cancer in urological patients. He will speak at 11 a.m. Thursday, May 1, on medical grand rounds on the subject of "Experimental and Clinical Observations Regarding the Etiology of Carcinoma of the Bladder." He will lecture at surgical grand rounds on Tuesday, April 29, on "The Use of the Bowel for Urinary Diversions -- Indications, Techniques and Complications and Results."

Dr. Harry Spence, chairman of the Division of Urology at Southwestern, and Dr. Paul C. Peters, associate professor of urology, will be hosts to Dr. Wallace during his Dallas visit.
