DALLAS--The University of Texas Board of Regents Friday awarded an \$188,450 contract for construction of an ophthalmology building on the UT Southwestern Medical School campus.

The one-story structure will contain 7,792 gross square feet, housing offices and laboratories of the medical school's Ophthalmology Department. Dowd Construction Co. of Dallas submitted the low bid.

Dr. John Lynn, chairman of the department, said the new building would allow an increase from three to six full-time faculty members.

Site will be on the west side of the campus near Medical Center Drive. Total cost of the installation, including furnishings and architects fees, will come to around \$250,000.
