DALLAS--Robert N. Dain, Ph.D., has been named assistant dean for academic affairs at the new UT School of Biomedical Sciences, according to Dr. Ronald Estabrook, dean of the less-than-one-year old school which incorporated all the graduate programs already in existence.

Dr. Dain, assistant professor of psychology, is the first administrator to serve in this position. His duties will include evaluating the quality of educational programs in the graduate school, counseling and assisting Dr. Estabrook in the organization and operation of the school. He also is chairman of the admissions committee.

The psychologist joined the graduate faculty at The University of Texas Health Science Center in 1969, after receiving his Ph.D. from U.T. in Austin. His previous professional experience includes service at R.H. Young Memorial Hospital, Omaha, Nebraska; St. Bernards Hospital, Council Bluffs, Iowa; and Glenwood State Hospital School, Glenwood, Iowa.

He is president elect of the Dallas Society of Clinical Psychologists.
