## BANK ONE DONATES \$125,000 TO UT SOUTHWESTERN

DALLAS — September 30, 1993 — Bank One, Texas, has pledged \$125,000 to The University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center at Dallas. The Bank One gift to the Fund for Molecular Research, a \$150 million fund-raising campaign, will receive dollar-for-dollar matching funds.

"Few projects are more worthy of private sector support, because the Fund for Molecular Research at UT Southwestern offers a direct investment in an extremely vital area of medical research," said Harvey Mitchell, chairman and chief executive officer of Bank One.
