DALLAS--Dr. Jack A. Pritchard of Dallas was one of six nationally prominent medical authorities who served as guest faculty members at a first-of-its-kind "team" conference of obstetricians and pediatricians held at Snowmass-at-Aspen, Colo.

Dr. Pritchard is Gillette professor of obstetrics and gynecology at The University of Texas (Southwestern) Medical School at Dallas.

The conference, an intensive five-day postgraduate course in perinatal medicine, offered a combined curriculum designed to strengthen the teamwork of specialists caring for mothers and their babies. More than 200 physicians attended from 40 states and Germany.

The course was jointly sponsored by the University of Colorado School of Medicine and the Colorado chapter of the American Academy of Pediatrics, the regional district of the American College of Obstetrics and Gynecology, and the Colorado Gynecological and Obstetrical Society. The sessions ended June 26.
