NEWS ITEM - SOUTHWESTERN MEDICAL SCHOOL OF THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS

Announcement has been received of award of the following United States Public Health Service grants to Southwestern Medical School of The University of Texas:

- (1) \$11,680.00 for research on "The Effects on the Volume of Blood in the Lungs and Respiration of Hemorrhage, Intravenous and Intra-arterial Infusions of Whole Blood, Saline and Dextrose Solutions in Normal, Sodium Depleted, and Traumatized Dogs" with Dr. Ben J. Wilson, Associate Professor and Acting Chairman of the Department of Surgery, and Dr. Allen F. Reid, Professor of Biophysics and Chairman of that Department, as principal investigators.
- (2) \$3,000.00 for research on "Use of Radioactive Diidofluorescein and Iodinated Human Serum Albumin in the Study of Vascular, Degenerative and Neoplastic Diseases of the Central Nervous System" with Dr. Ralph S. Clayton, Clinical Associate Professor of Radiology, as principal investigator.
- (3) \$10,692.00 for research on "The Effect of Homogenous Renal Transplants and Other Procedures on the Hypertension, Cardiovascular Lesions and Anemia Following Bilateral Nephrectomy" with Dr. E. E. Muirhead, Professor of Pathology and Chairman of that Department, as principal investigator.
- (4) \$14,000.00 for cardiovascular training with Dr. Howard E. Heyer, Clinical Professor of Medicine, as program director.
- (5) \$25,000.00 for cancer training with Dr. Andrew B. Small, Clinical Associate Professor of Surgery, as program director.
- (6) \$14,958.00 for undergraduate training in psychiatry with Dr. Don B. Morris, Professor of Neuropsychiatry, as program director.
