DALLAS--Cancer cell repair mechanisms will be investigated at the University of Texas Southwestern Medical School at Dallas with a grant of \$20,000 from the Paul J. and Adrienne Adam Foundation.

Dr. Eugene P. Frenkel, Professor of Internal Medicine, who will direct the research, explained that current day drug therapy is limited, not because there isn't a wide spectrum of drugs available, but because following treatment with drugs, many cancer cells are able to repair themselves.

"We hope to increase the efficacy of currently available drugs by interfering with the cancer cell's repair system," he added.

The Adam Foundation has made a number of grants to further medical research.
