**National expert to speak on drugs,
alcohol and teens

DALLAS--Dr. Donald Ian Macdonald, nationally known expert on alcohol, drugs and the adolescent, will give a 7 p.m. address January 17 at The University of Texas Health Science Center at Dallas, 5323 Harry Hines. The program, which will be in Gooch auditorium, is co-sponsored by the Dallas County Medical Society and the Dallas County Society Auxiliary.

Macdonald is president of the Florida Chapter of the American Academy of Pediatrics and the Florida Pediatric Society. His topic will be "Drugs, Drinking, and Adolescence."

Since 1980 the pediatrician has been director of clinical research at Straight, Inc., an adolescent drug treatment program in St. Petersburg, Fla. In 1981 he was president of the Scientific Advisory Board, American Council on Drug Education in New York, N.Y.

Earlier in the day Macdonald will address the health science center's pediatric and psychiatric house staffs and faculty members. He will talk about working with adolescent abusers at a noon meeting in the Doctors' Dining Room, Children's Medical Center.

The evening meeting is open to the public at no charge.
