THE SOUTHWESTERN MEDICAL SCHOOL OF THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS

Miss Janet Doe, Librarian of the New York Academy of Medicine, has announced the Academy's donation of 12,000 volumes to Southwestern Medical School of The University of Texas. These volumes are the larger portion of a gift of 20,000 volumes received by the New York Academy of Medicine from the New York Public Library. They represent the original collection of medical books accumulated by the New York Public Library during the nineteenth century when Dr. John Shaw Billings, earlier noted for his association with the Army Medical Library, was connected with the New York institution.

A grant of \$3,000 for work on new anti-infective agents has been made to Dr. Andres Goth, Associate Professor of Pharmacology, by the Sharp & Dohme Company.

Southwestern Medical School of The University of Texas is cooperating with the Dallas Southern Clinical Society, the Dallas Academy of Internal Medicine, and the Dallas Heart Association in offering a Postgraduate Course in Cardiology to be given in Dallas November 28 through December 1, 1949.
