DALLAS -- Dr. S. Edward Sulkin, Chairman of the Department of Microbiology at The University of Texas Southwestern Medical School at Dallas, will speak at medical conferences in Turkey and Iran this fall.

In Teheran, Iran, Dr. Sulkin will present results of studies of encephalitis of the type responsible for outbreaks of the disease in Houston in 1964 and in Dallas and Corpus Christi in 1966. The occasion will be the Eighth International Congresses on Tropical Medicine and Malaria.

The Dallas scientist will speak on the developments in rabies at an International Symposium on Rabies in Istanbul, Turkey, held in connection with the 80th anniversary of the founding of the Turkish Rabies Institute.
