DALLAS--John Bertrand, freshman medical student at The University of Texas Southwestern Medical School at Dallas, is one of four student representatives invited to participate in the 19th annual convention of Alpha Epsilon Delta, a pre-medical honor society.

Mr. Bertrand, son of Mr. and Mrs. Roy B. Bertrand Sr. of Waco, will speak on student programs and activities at the medical school. The convention is April 6-8 at the University of Arizona in Tucson.

In addition to his talk, the UTSWMS student will take part in a panel discussion dealing with careers in the health professions.
