DALLAS--Dr. Parkhurst Alan Shore, Professor of Pharmacology, has been named acting Associate Dean for Graduate Studies of The University of Texas Southwestern Medical School at Dallas.

Dr. Shore succeeds Dr. Frank Harrison, who has been named acting president of The University of Texas at Arlington. Dr. Shore's appointment was announced today by Dr. Charles C. Sprague, Southwestern dean.

A native of Washington, D. C., Dr. Shore, 43, holds bachelor's and master's degrees from George Washington University and a doctorate in pharmacology from Georgetown University. He served as a chemist in the National Institutes of Health, and as head of the section on biochemistry of drug action and deputy chief of the laboratory of chemical pharmacology of the National Heart Institute of NIH, at Bethesda, Md.

Dr. Shore joined the faculty of Southwestern in 1961 as Associate Professor of Pharmacology and was made professor in 1963.

A World War II Army veteran, Dr. Shore is a member of a number of professional societies in chemistry and pharmacology. He is co-editor of *Advances in Pharmacology*, member of NIH's Pharmacology-toxicology Review Committee and member of the editorial boards of a number of pharmacology journals. He is author or co-author of almost 80 scientific papers and publications in his chosen field.
