****Occidental donates \$250,000
to University Hospital

DALLAS - Ronald F. Garvey, M.D., M.B.A., president and chief executive officer of Zale Lipshy University Hospital at Southwestern Medical Center, announced today that Occidental Chemical Corporation has contributed \$250,000 to the hospital.

"We think University Hospital is going to be the catalyst that helps move Southwestern Medical School to the forefront in the medical arena," says Charles F. Hazzard, executive vice president of administration for OxyChem. "We want to say we had a hand in that when they arrive."

Joseph R. Musolino, general chairman of the Corporate Partnership Campaign for University Hospital, says he is pleased with the progress of fund raising. Musolino, vice chairman, Dallas, NCNB Texas, said the campaign is drawing in a lot of new players. "Companies like OxyChem are beginning to become involved with the medical community in the metroplex. This is a tremendous opportunity for companies to play key roles in the development of Dallas and Fort Worth as a medical mecca."

So far the corporate and big gifts campaigns have raised close to \$10 million.

University Hospital opened last November. It is a 160-bed private referral, teaching, and research hospital for faculty physicians at The University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center at Dallas.
