NEW ANESTHESIOLOGY CHAIRMAN

DALLAS--Dr. Paul F. White has been named chairman of the Department of Anesthesiology and holder of the Margaret Milam McDermott Chair in Anesthesiology at The University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center at Dallas.

White comes to UT Southwestern from Washington University Medical Center in St. Louis, where he was director of clinical research in the Department of Anesthesiology and assistant to the chairman and medical director of the Ambulatory Surgery Center at Barnes Hospital.

Known for his work in the areas of ambulatory anesthesia and acute postoperative pain management, White plans to expand both the clinical and research activities of the Department of Anesthesiology.

White received doctorates in medicine and pharmacology from the University of California, San Francisco. He was an assistant professor of anesthesia and director of the Outpatient Anesthesia Service at Stanford University Medical Center before joining the faculty at Washington University in St. Louis.
