DALLAS--Dr. Alsoph H. Corwin, professor at Johns Hopkins University, will visit The University of Texas Southwestern Medical School March 8 as a Robert A. Welch Foundation lecturer.

Dr. Corwin, a widely-known biochemist, will speak on "Heme as a Probe in the Investigation of Hemoglobin" at 8 p.m. in the first-floor lecture hall at the school.

A recipient of the Maryland Chemist's Award of 1964, Dr. Corwin has been a consultant to government and industry. He is the author of numerous scientific publications, many of which deal with the effects of metals and their compounds on physiology.

This is one of a series of lectures which will be given in Texas colleges and universities under sponsorship of the Houston-based Welch foundation.
