DALLAS--Students at Southwestern Medical School in Dallas are getting some very practical lessons in operations in addition to their regular scientific curriculum.

In a series of lectures sponsored by the American Medical Student Association and the Phi Beta Pi Medical Fraternity of Southwestern, students have heard Dr. Charles C. Sprague, president of the UT Health Science Center explain "Operating in a University System," and SCD Vice President Jack Wheeler talk about "Operating with the State Legislature." Southwestern Dean Dr. Frederick Bonte spoke on "Operating Within a Budget."

These seminars are intended to increase medical student awareness of the practical aspects of running a Health Science Center, according to Steven Dunnagan and Lanette Howell, officials of the student organizations.

Still to come are "Sources of Funding" presented by Julius Weeks, vice president for business affairs; "The Hospital and the Medical School," by Dr. Charles Mullins, associate dean for clinical affairs, on April 24 and May 1 respectively.

Highlight of the series will be a student meeting with County Judge Gary Weber and County Commissioner Roy Orr for a discussion of the relationship of "The Hospital and the Community" at a later date.
