## UT SOUTHWESTERN TOPS NATION IN PRIVATE GIFTS PER STUDENT

DALLAS — June 16, 1995 — UT Southwestern Medical Center at Dallas leads the nation in the dollar amount of private support donated per student.

A survey by the Council for Aid to Education shows that UT Southwestern received private gifts totaling \$32,665 per student in 1994. In the fall of the academic year surveyed, 1,680 students were enrolled in UT Southwestern's three schools: Southwestern Medical School, Southwestern Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences and Southwestern Allied Health Sciences School.

"Although UT Southwestern is a public institution, it is private support that is enabling us to become a world-class medical center," said Dr. Kern Wildenthal, UT Southwestern president. "We are proud of our partnership with the private sector and believe it is essential in our endeavor to recruit and retain an internationally recognized faculty," Wildenthal said.
