******UTHSCD professor named one of
nation's top 10 clinical pharma-
cologists by the Burroughs Wellcome
Fund.*

DALLAS--Dr. William A. Pettinger, professor and chairman of clinical pharmacology at The University of Texas Health Science Center at Dallas, has been selected one of the 10 distinguished scientists to serve as a Creasy Visiting Professor of Clinical Pharmacology.

During the week beginning February 7, Dr. Pettinger is visiting Louisiana State University School of Medicine to participate in teaching conferences with medical students and faculty. He is also conducting a series of lectures including the William N. Creasy Memorial Lecture on "Blood Pressure Regulatory Mechanisms and Antihypertensive Drugs in Man."

The Burroughs Wellcome Fund seeks to stimulate an increased interest in and support for clinical pharmacology which is concerned with the study of drugs in man, through the program of Creasy visiting professorships.

Dr. Pettinger, himself a Burrough-Wellcome Scholar in clinical pharmacology, received his M.D. degree from Creighton University. His internship and residency were completed at New Jersey Medical Center.

Dr. Pettinger is a member of the American Heart Association's Council for High Blood Pressure Research, the Southern Society for Clinical Investigation, and the board of directors of the American Society for Clinical Pharmacology and Therapeutics. He is also a fellow of the American College of Physicians and of Cardiology.
