SAN ANTONIO -- Dr. Philip O'Bryan Montgomery, Jr., 48, associate dean of The University of Texas (Southwestern) Medical School at Dallas, Friday was named special assistant to the deputy chancellor, UT System.

Dr. Montgomery, a nationally-recognized researcher and teacher, will continue as associate dean at Dallas in addition to his new assignment in Deputy Chancellor Charles A. LeMaistre's office.

Dr. LeMaistre said Dr. Montgomery's first assignment will be to assist in the planning and development of the new UT Medical School at Houston.

A graduate of Southern Methodist University and Columbia University Medical School in New York City, Dr. Montgomery joined (Southwestern) in 1952.

He is listed in Who's Who in American Medicine and is on the Scientific Advisory Committee of the Damon Runyon Fund for Cancer Research.

Dr. Montgomery is the author or co-author of more than 90 scientific papers.

Since being named associate dean of (Southwestern) in 1968, Dr. Montgomery has headed task forces planning the school's \$40 million Phase One building program.

Dr. Montgomery is a former president of the Dallas County Hospital District Medical Staff, and former Dallas County medical examiner. He is a member of around 30 medical and scientific societies.

In community activities, he is vice president of St. Mark's School of Texas, and a member of the board of Lamplighter School.
