DALLAS--A one-day workshop and seminar for medical librarians in Dallas and Tarrant counties will be sponsored here Jan. 26 by the Extension Services Division of the TALON Regional Medical Library Program.

The session to be from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. at St. Paul Hospital, will include a morning workshop for personnel who have had a minimum of professional training or those who feel they want a refresher in mechanisms of inter-library loans, according to Miss Katherine Haas, extension librarian for the TALON program which is based at The University of Texas Health Science Center in Dallas.

The afternoon session will feature presentations by Patricia Donovan, associate librarian for the Health Science Center and by Mrs. Kay Chichilla, inter-library loan librarian for the center, who will discuss mechanisms of inter-library loans. There will be a general session on the TALON (Texas, Arkansas, Louisiana, Oklahoma and New Mexico) Regional medical Library program. Miss Haas will present the program's network concept.

One attraction of the session will be demonstration of the MEDLINE system. MEDLINE is an "on-line" search system through which medical journal articles may be located by a computer in Washington on request from terminals such as the one located in the UT Health Science Center.

There will be a tour of the health center's library facilities.

In addition to the other events on the day's program, there will be a discussion of the feasibility of forming a Dallas-Tarrant County council of health science librarians.
