DALLAS--Donnie Lynn Vick has joined that select group of people who are getting athletic scholarships to medical school.

It's not that Southwestern Medical School is going in for team sports but that the National Collegiate Athletic Association awards a number of postgraduate scholarships for outstanding achievement in scholastic and athletic areas.

Vick, a freshman medical student at Southwestern, was All American three meter diver in 1972 and Southwest Athletic Conference winner in the three meter dive in 1973 for The University of Texas.

Mr. Vick was one of 80 athletes chosen whose grades were better than a three point average, the NCAA said. The scholarship is for \$1,000.
