## NEW POLICE CHIEF NAMED AT UT SOUTHWESTERN

DALLAS — March 8, 1996 — Larry E. Coutorie has been named chief of police at UT Southwestern Medical Center at Dallas. He is a former inspector with The University of Texas System Office of the Director of Police.

Coutorie, who has a bachelor of science degree in psychology from the State University of New York in Albany, is experienced in policy development, management inspections for operations and adherence to policies, position review, training development, team building, training and instruction.

He began his law enforcement career at The University of Texas at Austin in 1977. "I had a few months off before classes at the UT System police academy started," Coutorie said. "Meanwhile, I worked as a gate guard, a roving guard writing parking tickets and as a dispatcher."

He graduated from the academy in 1978 and by 1980 had become a sergeant. In 1983 he joined the Criminal Investigation Division of the campus police force.

Since then he has become a sought-after expert in white-collar computer crimes. He has investigated computer hacking and fraud incidents, including a computer break-in of U.S. government computers.

Coutorie has post graduate training from the Federal Bureau of Investigation National Academy. He is a licensed peace officer with a Master Peace Officer Certificate and Instructors Certificate from the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement Officer Standards and Education. He also is a certified fraud examiner, firearms instructor and scuba diver.

In 1990 he received the Larry Fultz Memorial Award for Outstanding Professionalism and Dedication from the Texas/New Mexico Association of College and University Police Departments.
