DALLAS--Five faculty members at The University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center at Dallas have been recognized recently for their contributions to their fields.

Dr. Kenneth Z. Altshuler, chairman of psychiatry and holder of the Stanton Sharp Distinguished Chair in Psychiatry, was honored by the Dallas Psychoanalytic Institute for helping establish and develop the psychoanalytic movement in Dallas.

Dr. George R. Buchanan, professor of pediatrics and director of pediatric hematology/oncology, was elected the region 5 representative to the Medical and Scientific Advisory Council of the National Hemophilia Foundation.

Dr. Dwight C. German, professor of psychiatry, was named 1992 distinguished biopsychology alumnus of the University of Oklahoma Health Science Center.

Dr. Willis C. Maddrey, vice president of clinical affairs and professor of internal medicine, was the American College of Gastroenterology's 1992 distinguished lecturer at the group's 57th annual meeting. Maddrey is president of the American College of Physicians.

Dr. Peggy J. Whalley, former Jack A. Pritchard Professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology, has been named a professor emeritus.
