DALLAS--A five-week series of programs on epilepsy to be broadcast by TV satellite will be held in Dallas in May. Sponsored by the Dallas Epilepsy Association, the Department of Biomedical Communications at The University of Texas Health Science Center at Dallas and the Division of Continuing Education at Medical University of South Carolina, the session, called "Current Concepts About Epilspsy," will be held at KERA-TV (PBS) in Dallas. The series is funded by the Department of Health Education, and Welfare.

The course, which is appropriate for physicians, nurses and other health personnel, may be taken for continuing education credits through the Medical University of South Carolina. Cost for the series is \$20. Individual sessions are \$5 each.

The schedule is as follows:

May 2--"An Overview Including Pathogenesis and Classification" and "Differential Diagnosis and Consideration of Prevention and Prognosis."

May 9--"Clinical Pharmacology and Medical Therapy"

May 16--"Seizures in Childhood" and "Problems in Adolescents and Adults Including Status Cases."

May 23--"Approach and Resources for Management" and "Surgical Treatment."

May 30--"Behavioral Problems," "The Human Experiences" and "Prospects for the Future."
