NEWS ITEMS - SOUTHWESTERN MEDICAL SCHOOL OF THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS

Dr. Don Morris, Professor of Neuropsychiatry in Southwestern Medical School of The University of Texas, has been elected a charter member of the American Academy of Child Psychiatry. Dr. Morris attended the meetings of the Group for the Advancement of Psychiatry in Asbury Park, New Jersey, on November 13-17 and on November 22-23 will preside at the meeting of the Texas Neuropsychiatric Association.

Dr. Gilbert B. Forbes, Professor and Chairman of the Department of Pediatrics, participated in the meeting of pediatric educators in New Orleans on November 8. This meeting was held for the purpose of bringing together the pediatric educators in Region V of the American Academy of Pediatrics to discuss improved pediatric teaching methods in the area.

Dr. S. At the meeting of the Texas Branch of the Society of American Bacteriologists in Austin on October 31 and November 1 Dr. Sulkin discussed "The Influence of Urethane on Susceptibility of Adult Mice to the Coxsackie Virus."

Dean G. N. Aagaard and Assistant Deans John Chapman and Robert Lackey attended the meeting of the Association of American Medical Colleges in Colorado Springs, Colorado, on November 9-12. Dean Aagaard is Chairman of the Association's Committee on Continuation Education.
