DALLAS--Three representatives of The University of Texas Southwestern Medical School will present portions of the program at a Southwest chapter meeting of the Biological Photographic Association in El Paso May 15 and 16.

Appearing will be Joseph Jackson, UTSMS medical art student, who will describe preparation of instructional materials for the health sciences; Mike Lorfing, medical photographic technician, who will discuss "The Photographer as a Polluter"; and Bill Stenstrom, assistant professor of medical art and ophthalmology, whose topic is "Stereoscopic Photography in Ophthalmology."

Judging of medical photographs and art work also will be a part of the program, at the El Paso Central Travelodge. The Biological Photographic Association, with 25 chapters and 1,000 members, is composed of photographers, illustrators and other communicators working in the biological sciences.
